

These Simple Methods Can Reveal Mold in Minutes

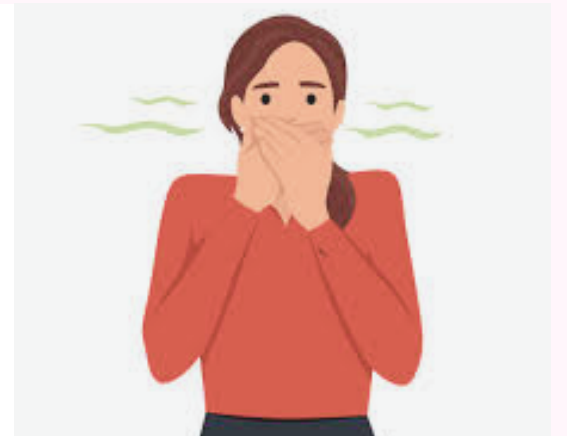


01 Quick Visual Inspection

Check common areas where mold grows, like bathrooms, attics, basements, and behind furniture.

Smell Test 02

Mold often smells damp and earthy. Do a smell test to detect this kind of odor.



03 Moisture Test

Mold grows in damp places. Check wall moisture or use a dry cloth on suspicious surfaces.

Ventilation Test 04

Poorly ventilated rooms trap moisture and are perfect for mold growth.



05 Vinegar Test

Spray white vinegar on suspicious areas and leave it. If the smell gets stronger, mold might be there.

Common Areas Where Black Mold Appears

01

Bathrooms:

Because of high humidity, bathrooms are a perfect spot for mold. Check around the shower, bathtub, toilet, and sinks.



02

Basements:

Poor ventilation and frequent moisture make basements mold-prone.



03

Attics:

Roof leaks and bad ventilation can cause mold in attics, especially on plywood.



04

Windows:

Condensation on windows can lead to mold on frames and sills.



05

Air Conditioners:

Moisture inside air conditioners can help mold grow.

Drywall:

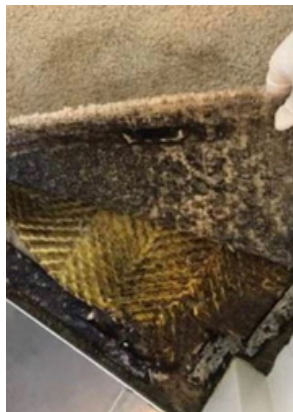
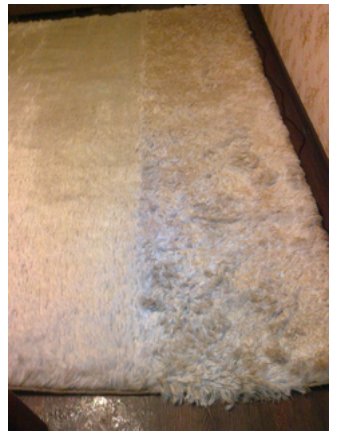
Drywall, especially in humid areas, it's very likely to grow mold.



06

Carpets:

Damp carpets or ones exposed to water can develop mold.



07

Wood:

Wood is organic and a food source for mold.



08

Concrete:

While less common, damp concrete, like in basements, can also grow mold.
